



*Take Heart Anoka County* is one of four sites participating in the national demonstration project, *Take Heart America*, which is designed to dramatically increase the number of people who survive sudden cardiac arrest (SCA). *Take Heart Anoka County* is connecting the public with the healthcare community through Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) education, increasing AED placement and supporting new technologies in Emergency Medical Services and cardiac hospital care.

The *Take Heart Anoka County* grant is funded by Mercy & Unity Hospitals Foundation, allowing the north metro community the opportunity to obtain CPR Anytime kits, education and AEDs.

The *Take Heart Anoka County* grant application is open to community organizations, clubs/groups, schools, churches, or businesses within *Take Heart Anoka County* area. (See page 3 for specific cities included in this area.)

## **Grant Requirements**

Applicants have the option to apply for two packages:

- 1) CPR Anytime Package and
- 2) AED Package. Applicants are required to create an implementation plan and provide a deposit for each package applied for. The deposit is payable to Mercy & Unity Hospitals Foundation and will be refunded upon completion of required reporting within 60 days of receiving your requested item(s). Reporting forms are available online at [www.takeheartanoka.org](http://www.takeheartanoka.org) or can be submitted by mail or email.
- 3) Deposits for each package are due at the time the CPR Anytime kits are received or when the AED order has been finalized.

# Take Heart Anoka County Grant Application Package Specifics



## CPR Anytime Package:

The package includes 5 to 60 CPR Anytime kits. Each kit includes Mini CPR Manikin, CPR skills Practice DVD, American Heart Association (AHA) CPR for Family and Friends Booklet, Mini Anne Spare Lung. The package also includes a one-hour train-the-trainer CPR session. Kits can be picked up at the scheduled one hour CPR session.

- Deposit = \$10.00 for each kit
- Applicants must train a minimum of 3 individuals for every kit received



## AED Package:

Includes choice of brand of AED, preparedness kit and wall mount storage cabinet. Package also includes an orientation session to help you decide which AED is most appropriate for your site and information on the use of an AED. The orientation session will also include information on AED maintenance needs. The AED selection is limited to the units offered under this grant opportunity.

- Deposit = \$400.00 per package (limit 1 per site)
- Applicants must conduct CPR training of a minimum of 25 individuals per site (*Take Heart Anoka County* can assist you with resources for completing the required CPR training.)
