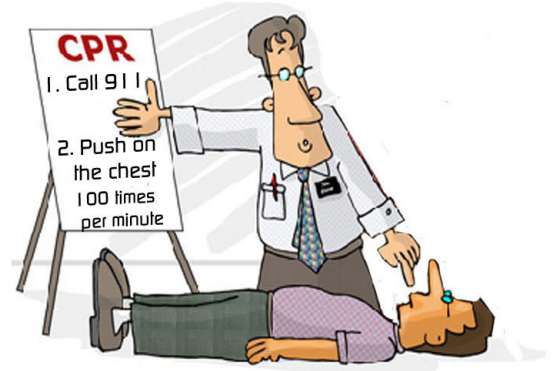


# Partnerships

## How do we get involved???



The goals of Take Heart Anoka include 25% of the Anoka County population trained in CPR. Statistically, only 20% of victims of Sudden Cardiac Arrest receive bystander CPR. Bystander CPR has shown to significantly improve survival rates. Take Heart Anoka County needs more people trained in CPR, LOTS more.

That's where you come in - we need your help.

There are several ways that partners can help us make this happen:

1. **Organization Partners**– Several community organizations come into contact with large numbers of the Anoka County population daily. These organizations are able to plan and carry out CPR Classes independent of the Take Heart staff. Classes can be held using CPR kit, the CPR Anytime video or traditional classes. Take Heart can assist with acquiring kits, publications, and informational support.
2. **Community Partners**– These are large companies or groups that would like to host a CPR class. They are responsible for facilities, registration and publicity of the event. Training could be done using any of the CPR training options.
3. **Business Partners**– These are companies that would like to develop plans to provide CPR kits to employees for their families or provide funding and/or facilities to community CPR classes.
4. **Other CPR Training Organization Partners**– These groups can help the Take Heart goals just by reporting what they are already doing. Take Heart can assist with any informational brochures for classes as requested.
