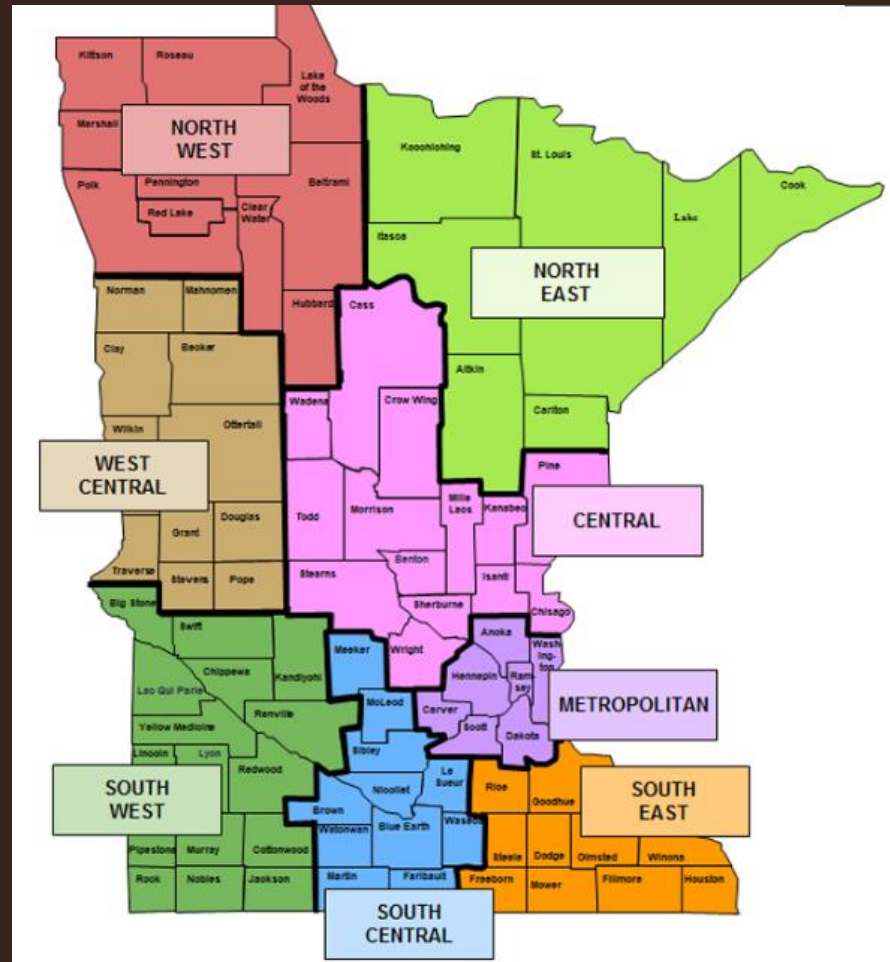

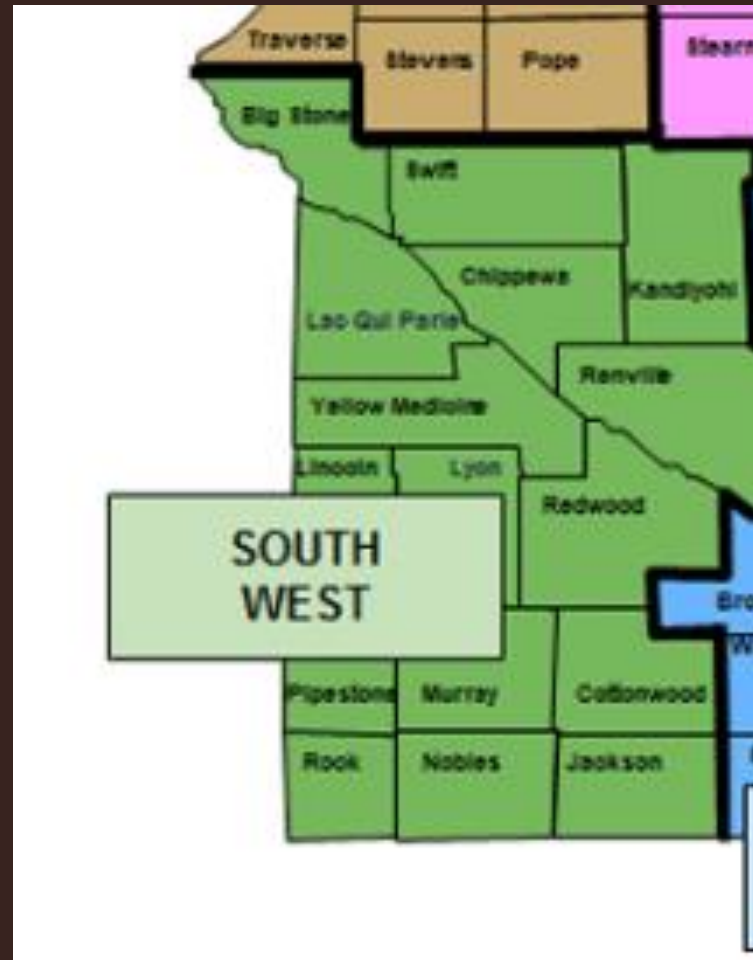

- Uniform educational standards
- Uniform protocols of cardiac care
- Uniform data collection using MNSTAR
- One Medical Director

STRATEGIES/HOSPITAL

- Strategies based upon the components of the Minnesota State Trauma System
- Focus upon “time sensitive medical emergencies”
- A regional approach utilizing the members of the regional trauma advisory councils
 - SMRTAC, SWRTAC
- Data collection based upon THA benchmarks obtained through each hospital's EMR
